NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ADOPT OR AMEND A
CONFLICT-OF-INTEREST CODE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the California State University Risk Management Authority intends to adopt or amend a conflict-of-interest code pursuant to Government Code Section 87300 and 87306. Pursuant to Government Code Section 87302, the code will designate employees who must disclose certain investments, income, interests in real property and business positions, and who must disqualify themselves from making or participating in the making of governmental decisions affecting those interests.

A written comment period has been established commencing on November 3, 2015 and terminating on December 18, 2015. Any interested person may present written comments concerning the proposed code no later than December 18, 2015 to the California State University Risk Management Authority, 100 Pine Street, 11th Floor, San Francisco, CA 94111. No public hearing on this matter will be held unless any interested person or his or her representative requests no later than 15 days prior to the close of the written comment period, a public hearing.

The California State University Risk Management Authority has prepared a written explanation of the reasons for the designations and the disclosure responsibilities and has available all of the information upon which its proposal is based.

A conflict-of-interest code is being adopted to identify the officials that make or participate in making governmental decisions.

NOTE: This notice should be filed with the Fair Political Practices Commission and served individually on agency employees and officers affected by this code 45 days prior to agency action.
